## GOLF HOLIDAYS 2007-2008



### INNERKIP HIGHLANDS INNERKIP, ONTARIO

Located near a small town in the middle of classic Ontario farmland, Innerkip Highlands is not a Championship course, nor is it a course of tricks and targets. It is a classic 6333 yard golf course which doesn't try to be more than it is, which fits the land beautifully, and asks the golfer to think about every single shot before he looks in his bag. There are opportunities to hit every club, to attack the course at times and play defensively at others. There are large greens and small greens, some with undulations, others appear to be flat—but are not. The par 3's are so innocent and so receptive to bogeys.

Narrow fairways lined with pine trees and low hanging branches swallow wayward shots whilst other holes appear wide open, but there is always something to distract the casual player. There are also some towering maple trees and a large stream which cuts through the course to provide even more variation to a number of holes. The course is always in excellent condition, and the greens here can run exceptionally fast. This is a very well run facility, with the attention to detail that is often missing from other public courses, not least of which is the pace of play, usually four hours at this well marshalled course.

Although the short 5th with its island green is best known, the 10th is probably our favourite hole. A straightaway par 5 lined with trees left and right, slightly downhill, but some 100 yards from the green the stream runs directly across the fairway. Beyond it the apron runs severely uphill to an elevated multi-tiered green with wicked slopes and surrounded by huge maple trees which mean it is often in the shade. Many hitters these days will be tempted to "go for it", but the shorter hitter in your group is likely to take a lower score.

It has a grand new clubhouse, with a vaulted ceiling nearly 40ft high made from 2ft sq. laminated beams of pine. Huge glass windows allow a full view of the golf course and it is a pleasure to be able to watch the golfers playing up the 18th hole, whilst you enjoy the view in the shade with a cool beverage. The food is strictly casual, but well made, and the service is excellent.

This is a day of golf to relax and enjoy. You will probably finish your round with the same ball if you play the course sensibly, and if the golf gods are kind to you, you might leave the course with a career low score. Good luck!
