## GOLF HOLIDAYS 2007-2008



### STOREY CREEK CAMPBELL RIVER, BRITISH COLUMBIA

Storey Creek Golf Course, situated 14 kms south of Campbell River, is widely publicized as "a Course in Nature". Located on Vancouver Island's beautiful East Coast, Storey Creek Golf Course is surrounded by the nature that makes the area famous.

Designed by Les Furber, this amazing golf course is surrounded by great West Coast trees, travelled by an abundance of wildlife and made even more attractive with its creeks, ponds and manicured gardens. It has consistently earned the prestigious Golf Digest Places to Play Award, most recently given a Four Star Rating, and has been listed in Score Magazine's Top 100 Golf Courses in Canada. Storey Creek has also hosted the 1999 BCGA Men's Amateur, and the 2003 BCGA Mid Amateur.

Strategically located bunkers and water hazards throughout the course inspire a carefully planned approach to each challenging hole. Four sets of tees allow every golfer to select their desired degree of difficulty with a range from 5434 to 6699 yards, par 72. The Slope rating from the men's gold tee is 72.5/133.

Carved out of dense coniferous and deciduous forest each fairway is framed by tall trees, creating a real sense of solitude and tranquility, and players rarely catch a glimpse of other groups. In addition there are subtle changes of elevation on many holes. Combined with the many natural hazards, golfers will find club selection challenging, particularly if there is any breeze, as the wind is very hard to gauge below the tree tops.

With creeks meandering alongside and dissecting fairways, Storey Creek flourishes as a sanctuary for many species of flora and fauna. Throughout the year you will see multitudes of deer grazing or lazing on any given hole. The sound of woodpeckers and the sight of eagles soaring and swooping will undoubtedly distract you from your golf but the mandate of the Board of Directors is to keep the course as close to its natural state as possible, while enjoying "a Course in Nature".
