THE ROCK MUSKOKA, ONTARIO

The Rock Golf Club, designed by legendary golfer Nick Faldo, has been artfully sculpted on the shores of one of Muskoka's premier lakes, Lake Rousseau. Utilizing the site's dynamic topography, the 6545-yard course is carved tight with narrow tree-lined fairways and sloping greens that wind through rock outcroppings, hardwood trees and rolling hills.

Faldo's in-depth knowledge of the game's finer subtleties and intricacies, combined with his considerable worldwide experience is reflected in his talent as a course designer. The Rock boasts natural hazards and challenges that reward accuracy, a tribute to Faldo's abilities as "the shot-maker." And, the course has been crafted in such a way so as to inspire golfers of all levels with an emphasis on strategy and playability.

The Canadian shield geography of the Muskoka area is like no other in the world. The pine forests and sculptured granite make for a beautiful backdrop, creating some of the world's most challenging golf.

The par 5 ninth hole is an exceptional hole, 640 yards downhill, which might indicate the back tees are not for you—but you do have gravity on your side. The hole doglegs sharply from right to left and there is a pond to negotiate from the tee and another for your second. However, the second shot across the pond on the corner is not a long carry and cuts some considerable distance off the hole. The green below you has three tiers and club selection on the approach is important to this 33 yard long green.

Muskoka golfing is rich in tradition, but no golf course exemplifies Muskoka golf like The Rock Golf Club. It was voted Best New Course in Canada by Golf Digest when it opened in 2004.

The Rock Steakhouse & Grille is the perfect finish to a day on the course or an afternoon at the lake. The mission-style clubhouse features a contemporary steakhouse experience in a fun, casual environment.
