GOLF HOLIDAYS 2007-2008



WHISTLER GOLF CLUB WHISTLER, BRITISH COLUMBIA

Whistler Golf Club is Arnold Palmer's first Canadian design, and home to a truly "Whistler" brand of golf. You'll sense it the minute you approach the Clubhouse, a guest host sporting a wide smile and a friendly attitude will greet you, take your clubs and acquaint you with the Club.

Stunning views of Whistler and Blackcomb mountains will amaze golfers at every turn, and while the sights may distract, signature design and uncompromising course conditions are standard fare. The friendly, relaxed and helpful personality of the course staff make a Whistler Golf Club experience uniquely Whistler. They call it "Palmer's design, Whistler's attitude".

The Whistler Golf Club's 18 sprawling fairways are virtually surrounded by mountains rising up all around them. The course measures 6676 yards, with a par of 72 and a Slope rating of 132. Breathtaking views of world-renowned Whistler and Blackcomb Mountains greet golfers at every turn. Playing in the valley makes for a very fine walking course, and this will allow you to savour the natural setting. Nine lakes fed by two winding creeks, towering stands of ancient cedar and the course's forested borders offer a spectacular backdrop, as well as a home for black bear, coyote, beaver and an abundance of fish and bird life.

Two of our favourite holes are the two par fives on the back nine. Hole #11, Arnie's Eagle, is 515 yards, handicap index 6 and unless you kill a drive, risking out of bounds right, going for the green in two isn't worth it. Aim left centre off the tee and hit an iron between the two creeks. This will leave you anywhere from 110-160 yards in, where four bunkers guard a very tough green. Hole #16, The Gallery, is 460 yards, handicap index 10 and has an incredible view! A good tee shot gives you a chance to hit the green in two, but be careful, this green is very well guarded by water and sand.

After your round, a pleasant refreshment on the small patio beside the 18th green will give you the opportunity to relive your round, and you may be tempted to see if there is another tee-time available for a few more holes before the late evening summer sunset!
