As you drive through the delightful town of Baddeck located at the southern tip of the World famous Cabot Trail you get the feeling that Bell Bay Golf Club will be something very special. And you will not be disappointed!

You are guaranteed a warm welcome from Head Professional, Ted Stonehouse - Canadian Club Professional of the Year 2002. Stroll onto the first tee and you will be thrilled with the condition of the tees and general tidiness of the course - every last detail has been taken care of at Bell Bay and when you reach the first green be prepared to putt on some of the finest greens in Canada... they are perfect!

After a gentle opening few holes meandering through the tree-lined fairways and gentle slopes, the downhill par three 8th will require a well struck iron shot to help you make par.

The back nine just gets better and better. The par five 13th and par three 14th will require a steely nerve with water running along the left side of both fairways and greens. The 15th and 16th holes both require two precise shots before you arrive at Bell Bay's signature hole - the par three 17th. This magnificent par three with carry over an environmentally protected area has the potential to be a real card wrecker - only a perfectly struck mid-iron or rescue wood will find the putting surface.

The 18th hole has spectacular views overlooking the waterways of Kempt Head and is a delightful finishing hole before you head to the clubhouse for a tasty Maritime lunch.
