### SALMON ARM GOLF CLUB SALMON ARM, BRITISH COLUMBIA

Salmon Arm Golf Club, located some 40 miles east of Kamloops, is an outstanding example of golf in the interior. Surprisingly, the course has a great history, first constructed in 1928 and re-designed by Les Furber in 1994, the course is as natural and as challenging as one could possibly imagine.

The extinct volcano cone of Mount Ida dominates the area of Salmon Arm and it is this stunning natural feature that perhaps inspired renowned golf course architect Les Furber to help in the re-design of the award-winning course. Salmon Arm is very highly regarded throughout the golfing community, and is ranked #16 in Canada by Score Golf Magazine and rated #1 in British Columbia by readers of Pacific Golf Magazine.

The immaculate tees, fairways and greens of this championship 18-hole course meander the flanks of the mountain in a classic layout amid towering indigenous firs and pines. Carved through ancient forest, this is a course where accuracy is paramount, and whilst the fairways are of a generous width, missing them is surely at least a one shot penalty.

The Salmon Arm Golf Club was created by individuals who believed it was possible to build a unique and interesting golf course that embodied the spirit and creativity of the founding members, and incorporated the natural beauty and defining features of the slopes of Mount Ida. The Club maintains its heritage by combining the simple enjoyment of a memorable golf experience with pioneer hospitality in a visually stunning setting.

The 11th hole stands out as one of the most challenging holes on any golf course. At 407 yards, bending slightly to the left, it requires a long drive, preferably with a slight draw around a lone pine tree. This will leave a significantly uphill shot over water to an undulating green, where two putts will be a fine achievement.

Unspoiled by development, though a small airstrip lines the early holes, the Salmon Arm Golf Club continues to offer nearly seamless integration with the undisturbed coniferous forest of the Salmon Valley.
