THE EAGLES GLENN PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND

The Eagles Glenn is a new championship golf course in the heart of Cavendish Beach. Renowned Canadian golf course architect Graham Cooke transformed over 300 acres of beautiful countryside into an 18 hole championship golf course with a state of the art practice facility. In a refreshing change to the modern standard, Cooke designed Eagles Glenn to make walking enjoyable, and this is by far the nicest way to enjoy this gently undulating layout.

The Eagles Glenn consists of ten par fours, four par fives, and four par threes. Five distinct teeing areas on each hole provide the right level of play for every golfer and the playing yardage from the back tees is 6785 yards, 5075 yards from the forward tees. The course has a challenging slope rating of 138 from the backs.

The sculpted fairways of this links style layout will offer some challenging lies, and there are plenty of fairway and greenside bunkers, placing a premium on accuracy at Eagles Glenn. The large, undulating greens are fast and offer several demanding pin positions. Four large ponds and white sand bunkers add to the beauty and the challenge of the course.

Inspiring views give each hole a unique personality. Bent grass greens, tees and fairways are bordered with deep green Kentucky blue grass and fescue. Graham Cooke is the magician of mounding and of capturing the unique character of the land, but the course retains plenty of it's original landscape. There is no doubt these are championship calibre holes with breathtaking views. Eagles Glenn - elegantly sculptured, a masterpiece!
