



HAMPTON INN KAMLOOPS, BRITISH COLUMBIA

The Hampton Inn, Kamloops, is one of those city hotels which is very much a case where looks can be somewhat deceiving. Whilst the exterior of the property is a rather drab brick and window, this hotel offers some of the nicest and most modern hotel rooms anywhere in the province. The rooms are spacious, and those on the front of the property offer splendid views over the town and hoodoo mountains beyond.

Now part of the Hilton hotel chain, the hotel offers everything one requires for the travelling golfer. Convenient parking directly in front of the hotel, fast check-in and check-out times, and a breakfast buffet bar which although by no means luxurious, is freshly prepared and offers an array of cooked or cold foods in a smart, efficient manner.

The hotel has some 80 rooms, most of which have two double beds, although there are some larger suites with king bed and office appointments. The rooms are really what sets this hotel apart. They offer large, very comfortable beds, modern fittings, many with flat screen TV's, together with bathrooms offering an excellent shower and chic accessories.

The hotel also has an excellent swimming pool and fitness area.

Although the hotel does not have a bar or dining room, there are plenty of bars and restaurants in the area, most within a short walk, and golfers generally will find a good array of choices to satisfy a variety of tastes.

The hotel is easily accessed from the highway, which is located in front of the hotel across the road, so the property is considerably quieter than it's neighbours. All in all, this is an excellent example of a modern, clean, basic hotel which those on a budget or travelling in groups will find more than acceptable, particularly as the staff are a cut above the norm in efficiency and politeness.
